# Women's History Month Spotlight: 31 Remarkable Women Who Changed the World



1. **Susan B. Anthony,** crusader for the women's suffrage movement. Aside from her advocacy for women's suffrage, Anthony also campaigned extensively for the abolition of slavery and the labor rights of women.

2. **Clara Barton**, Civil War nurse and founder of the American Red Cross. Barton played a pivotal role during the American Civil War by operating hospitals on the front lines of Virginia. In 1881, she established the American

Red Cross, which continues to operate and provide humanitarian aid across the world today.



### 3. Harriet Tubman,

American abolitionist and armed spy for the Union Army during the American Civil War. Tubman, herself an escaped slave, helped hundreds of slaves escape the South by means of the Underground Railroad. She nursed Union troops during the Civil War and took on spying missions at great personal risk. Her actions earned her the

nickname "Moses of her people."

## 4. Sojourner Truth,

abolitionist and women's rights advocate. Sojourner Truth escaped slavery with her infant daughter in 1826. In 1828, Truth

brought a case to recover her son to court and won the filing — and was the first black woman to achieve such a victory over a white man. She became an outspoken advocate for civil rights and women's rights until her death in 1883.
